# Hail to the New Chief at TABC

**Joel Moreno** recently became the first Hispanic chief of enforcement and operations for the **Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission (TABC)** one of the highest positions ever held by a Hispanic at the agency. The **TABC** employs nearly 700 employees across the state, and is the state agency responsible for regulating and supervising all aspects of the alcoholic beverage industry in Texas.

*"Chief Moreno represents the changing face of the agency, the state and the nation. His promotion represents the agency's strong commitment to diversity and continuous movement toward a modern era of inclusion and opportunity for all,"* says **TABC Commissioner José Cuevas**.

**He's earned his place among the agency's top leaders by virtue of his achievements . . .**

He's earned his place among the agency's top leaders by virtue of his achievements and a character forged by a personal understanding of struggle and hardship, education and opportunity. *"His rise through the ranks serves as a beacon for other minority employees to show them that not only do they belong in the organization, but they are leading the agency,"* **Commissioner Cuevas** continues.

A humble man, **Chief Moreno** speaks with soft-spoken humility and generous respect, *"I don't want to be known for being the first Hispanic chief of enforcement. I want to be known for having provided the best services possible for the people of*

*Texas,"* **Moreno** says. *"The badge doesn't belong to me; it belongs to the people."*

**Humble Beginnings**

As the son of farm workers, he was picking tomatoes in the hot, steaming fields of the **Rio Grande Valley** by the time he was 11 years old, an age when most kids were watching TV in the comfort of air-conditioned homes.

When he was 15, he made a life-changing decision. That summer, he rode in the back of a dusty, rumbling pickup for more than a thousand miles from **McAllen to Minnesota** as his family followed another ripe crop to keep food on the table. After 18 straight hours of unloading 100-pound sacks of potatoes from a railroad car, **Joel** realized he needed to follow his mother's advice and pursue a higher education. And so he did.

**Chief Moreno** found his way into college and went on to earn his bachelor of science degree in criminal justice at the **Pan American University in Edinburg, Texas**. He then went to work for the **McAllen Police Department** in 1980.

In 1985 he was hired by the **Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission** and over the last 22 years has worked his way up the ranks of **TABC** in **Laredo, McAllen, Brownsville, Houston, Corpus Christi, Odessa** and **Austin**. Recently, the **Texas Commission on Law Enforcement Officer Standards**

and **Education** awarded him a master peace officer certification for the 27 years he has served the public as a peace officer.

Positive optimism defines his demeanor and defies the hardships of his youth. Always quick with a kind word of encouragement, he remains grateful for his good fortune and the lessons learned from his life in the barrio. *"Each time I go back to the projects, I look for the children. I can see myself in those kids. I was that kid,"* he reflects.

**Change Agent.**

Always on the move, **Chief Moreno** brings his dedication to public service wherever he goes. He builds community, inspires unity, encourages dreams and instills the confidence to achieve them. With every opportunity, **Chief Moreno** advocates for education. He reaches out to make a difference. *"I encourage the kids to dream big and get a good education. I go out to the neighborhoods because I want to gain the trust of the community, especially minority communities,"* he says.

Armed with a sincere desire to make a difference in a child's life, **Chief Moreno** travels across the state to speak at schools and community events to raise awareness about the dangers and consequences of underage drinking. He says emphatically, *"I want community leaders to believe that education builds strength in a community a strength that can bring about social change."*

Ensuring public safety is among his most important missions as chief, especially the enforcement of underage drinking laws. *"One of the greatest threats to our youth and their future is underage drinking. By bringing together people with a common purpose and building community partnerships, we have a better chance of reaching our young people with a prevention message,"* he says. *"I want people to know the TABC is not only about enforcement and regulation. We aren't the bad guys, we're here to help."*

## Preguntas y Respuestas Sobre el Cáncer del Seno

**¿Que es el Proyecto Mermaid?** El Proyecto Mermaid, es un programa al alcance de Brazosport Health Foundation que ofrece mammografía gratuita, cuidado diagnóstico y tratamiento de cáncer del seno a mujeres en el sur del Condado de Brazoria.

**¿Quién cualifica para estos servicios?** Para cualificar para estos servicios, la mujer debe de ser de bajos recursos economicos, sin seguro de salud y residente del sur del Condado de Brazoria. Un cuarto (1/4) de residentes del Condado de Brazoria estan sin seguro de salud, y un quinto (1/5) de los habitantes tienen ingresos menos de \$25,000 annual. Hay más de 27,000 mujeres que cualifican para servicios con el Proyecto Mermaid.

**Me encuentro con un bulto en el pecho y no tengo seguro de salud. ¿Como puedo obtener ayuda?** Llame al Proyecto Mermaid al numero 979-297-3733 y hable con la coordinadora de paciente, Monica Razo. Ella es enfermera bilingüe y su papel es ayudar a cualificar mujeres en el proceso diagnóstico y tratamiento.

**¿Cuanto cuesta la Mammografía con el Proyecto Mermaid?** Para mujeres que cualifican, todos los costos estan cubiertos por el Proyecto. No hay ningún costo para examen de clinica para el seno, trabajo diagnóstico o tratamiento.

**Mi medico escribio una receta para la mammografía, pero yo no puedo pagar.** No hay ningún cargo para mamogram que e hacen con el Proyecto Mermaid. Todo mammografía se hacen en el **Brazosport Regional System**.

**Yo no puedo ir con un medico y no tengo receta para una mammografía. ¿Puedo todavia que me hagan examen?** El Proyecto Mermaid le puede ser una cita con el el medico para que usted reciba un examen del seno luego, si es necesario le toman la mammografía. Estas visitas seran pagadas por el Proyecto Mermaid.

**¿Que pasa si soy diagnosticada con cancer del seno y no puedo pagar el costo del tratamiento?** Mujeres quien cualifican por el **Proyecto Mermaid** reciben los servicios y el tratamiento gratuita.

**¿Si es de que necesito una operación o tratamiento, tendria que viajar a Houston o Galveston?** En muchos casos, su cancer se puede tratar en **Brazosport Regional Cancer Center**. Si es de haiga circunstancias, Proyecto Mermaid calobará con facilidades en Houston para su tratamiento, y continuará pagando por estos tratamientos.

**¿Cómo puede mi familia ayudarme con esta situación medica?** El Proyecto Mermaid patrocina grupos de apoyo mensuales de cancer del seno. Estas juntas se llevan acabo más de las 10:00a.m.-11:00 a.m. en el cuarto piso de Brazosport Regional Health System en la habitación Multipurpose Room. No hay costo para que venga apoyar este grupo. Y no es necesario que usted este recibiendo tratamiento de cancer en **Brazosport Regional Cancer Center** Usted es bienvenido para asistir a este grupo.

**¿Deberas necesito un mamogam? Mi mama y mi abuela nunca tuvieron uno y estan bien.** El 80% de cancer en el seno ocurre en mujeres sin factores de riesgo. Cancer de seno es más común encontrado en mujeres después de cancer en la piel. Es el Segundo causa de cancer en mujeres. Es recomendado para mujeres que obtengan una mammografía ya cuando llegan as los 40 años. Cancer del seno se puede tartar con más si se encuentra más temprano.

**¿Como puedo probar mi residencia en el Condado de Brazoria?** Cuando se registre para su mammografía, en **Brazosport Regional Health System**, le requieren que muestre su licencia de manejar o una tarjeta de identificación. Usted debe de vivir en estos codigo postales: 77422, 77430, 77480, 77486, 77511, 77541, 77542, 77515 77534, 77566, 77577 y 77583.
